Update on TNWG Emergency Services in 3 minutes or less...

Rockwood / Union City SAREX – The SAREX at Union City on December 14th through December 16th was canceled due to weather. There were 51 people preregistered for the exercise. This is a great turnout. We have decided to add Union City as an operating location to the Rockwood SAREX scheduled for Jan 18th through the 20th. The budget is planned for all wing aircraft. There will be ground training and operations at both locations. The two locations are listed separately in the pre-registration tool so please sign up for the location you will be attending. As usual, there will be space at each location for sleeping bag overnights as well as transport to local hotels. Union City is planning on having \$5 meals available.

Mission Aircrew School – There is a Mission Aircrew School planned for Jan 11th through the 13th at the Collegedale Airport in Group 2 (FGU). It will be an Air only event focused on Aircrew Training. Please pre-register if you are planning on attending.

Fiscal Cliff – We are not sure what our operating budget will be going forward. We are fully funded through March which is likely to be the soonest we will receive additional funds. We are looking at how we can continue ES training if additional funding will not be available.

Collegedale Mission – Tennessee Wing was tasked by AFRCC to find the pilot of an experimental aircraft that had departed Collegedale (FGU) airport. An initial night sortie did not receive any ELT signals. The aircraft was located near the field by an inbound aircrew during the initial stand up of the mission base at FGU. At the time the aircraft was found we had 4 aircraft, 4 Ground teams and an MCP at or inbound to FGU. Special Thanks to Marty Nix(IC), Tommy Jones (MP) and Carlos Ortiz (MO) for the fine effort. Thanks to everyone in Tennessee Wing who responded or assisted in our rapid reaction to this tragic incident. I am very pleased with the speed and professionalism of our response.
