Update on TNWG Emergency Services in 3 minutes or less...

SAREX in Smyrna – The next item on our training calendar will be the SAREX in Smyrna. This exercise was rescheduled to the weekend of the 27th. This will be a fully funded exercise with ferry planned for all wing aircraft. Ground team activities will take place all day at a location away from the ICP. Details of the schedule and locations will be sent out in a separate email.

Maintaining Quals – It is very difficult to maintain focus on ES quals and readiness in the face of a downturn in actual missions (good thing for an ES organization) and our current budget condition (bad thing for an ES organization). We are pursuing additional tasking with our existing customers and looking for new customers. A large portion of our ‘marketing’ is our qualification numbers. Please continue to work on sqtr signoffs at meetings and on a local level. We need to maintain our numbers and availability for the actual missions we do receive.

SET Qualification – E-services continues to evolve in the area of sqtr sign offs. Please be aware that starting April 22nd, a trainer has to be designated as an SET for a task before E-Services will allow the sign off with that trainers number. The quals you are an SET for are indicated on your 101 card with a diamond. Please make sure that the 101 card you bring to an event properly indicates your status if you plan on acting as an SET. Group and Unit ESOs – There have been several changes in command staff at the group and unit levels. Please check your unit and group staff for any changes.
