Update on TNWG Emergency Services in 3 minutes or less...

SAREX in Knoxville – The next item on our training calendar will be the SAREX in Knoxville. This will be a fully funded exercise with ferry planned for all wing aircraft. Completed Smyrna Exercise – The exercise in Smyrna was a success despite the continuing poor weather on the backup dates. We were able to fly several highbird sorties and several GIIEP / Photo Sorties. We had 71 total personnel, 3 aircraft, 3 vehicles and we flew 13.4 hours in 7 sorties. The TNNG was present with GIIEP equipment and the Rutherford County EMA observed the operation as well.

Actual Mission in Memphis – Tennessee wing received another find on 5/2/2013. A ground team from Group 3 deployed to Memphis and located the 406 mhz ELT in a FedEx truck at a depot near the airport. Thanks to everyone who made the long drive at a late hour to locate the ELT. Everyone in the wing needs to be aware that we can receive a mission at any time and only fully qualified personnel who are safety current can respond.

Ongoing Budget Issues – We have now received the balance of our training budget. Our total so far is 33,000. At this point we have spent %17 of our total budget and our fiscal year is 54% complete. We will have to work hard to benefit from the total amount of the training fund this year. Please ensure that every aircraft in the wing is crewed for every exercise on the calendar. We need maximum effort until the end of the fiscal year. Pilot training that was deferred due to lack of funds will be planned and announced.
