Update on TNWG Emergency Services in 3 minutes or less...

SAREX in Bolivar – The next exercise on the calendar is in Bolivar TN at M08 airport. We have \$5000 in funding for this one and we need to see as many airplanes and ground teams there as possible. We will be flying actual ESRs, SAR and GIIEP / Photo flights along with ground team sorties and staff training.

Completed Knoxville Exercise – The exercise in Knoxville was a great success. We were able to fly several highbird sorties and several GIIEP / Photo Sorties. We had only 35 total personnel, 5 aircraft, 2 vehicles and we flew 46 hours in 40 sorties. The TNNG was present with GIIEP equipment. N1354E suffered a vacuum pump failure and has since been repaired.

Actual Mission in Nashville – Tennessee wing received another find on 6/8/2013. After investigating airplanes at two airports and several blimps the find was made at MQY. Thanks to the aircrew and ground teams that responded and to the staff. Everyone in the wing needs to be aware that we can receive a mission at any time and only fully qualified personnel who are safety current can respond.

Actual Mission in Centerville – Tennessee wing received another find on 5/25/2013. The 121.5 ELT was located at Hoenwald Airport. Thanks to everyone who took the time to join in the effort. Every find we make is noted by AFRCR and CAP USAF. Your continued support is greatly appreciated.
