OPS EVAL – The Tennessee Wing Ops Eval is scheduled for December 6-9 2013. Every two years we have to demonstrate our ability to conduct our ES missions to an Air Force Evaluation Team. This year we will also have visitors from the National Guard and other Tennessee Agencies as well as Air Force. This is our chance to show what we are capable off. This evaluation exercise is intended primarily as a demonstration of what we can do not as a training event but there will be opportunities for training and renewal of qualifications. No Notice Exercise – TEMA initiated a no-notice exercise for Tennessee wing in conjunction with their graded exercise for Watts Bar Power Plant. Our participation in this exercise was limited to reporting our availability. We learned several lessons from this exercise. These requests for us to report our availability are an important part of the ES mission process. The faster and more accurate our reports are the better chance we have of being tasked in a real incident. Many times it is the first experience an emergency manager has with our organization. In order to provide the best response to these requests it is important that replies come through the proper chain.
