**Resource reporting** – We are commonly asked for our available resources when an agency is considering requesting our assistance. Responding to these requests quickly and accurately is important to increasing the visibility of Civil Air Patrol to emergency managers in Tennessee. When a request goes out please report your availability directly to the contact that is specified. If the request is for a report by unit then it is expected that the unit commander or ESO gathers the reports for the unit and provides one report to the Group ESO or commander. The groups will then combine the unit reports and report to wing. Please ensure that you know who in your squadron or group will be collecting the reports, and how to contact them. If you receive a blast email do not use reply to all, please reply only to the sender or to the contact specified in the mail.

**Squadron Level training** – The bulk of ES training should be accomplished at the unit level. Most of the tasks in the SQTRs can be accomplished on a meeting night. Every item on the SQTR has a corresponding description and performance criteria in the task guide.
