Update on TNWG Emergency Services in 3 minutes or less...

OPS EVAL – The rescheduled OPS EVAL will be held at McGee Tyson Airport in Alcoa, TN on June 7/8 2014. This event will replace the Greenville SAREX scheduled for the previous weekend.

Squadron Level training – The bulk of ES training should be accomplished at the unit level. Most of the tasks in the SQTRs can be accomplished on a meeting night. Every item on the SQTR has a corresponding description and performance criteria in the task guide. Task guides can be found on the NESA web site: <http://www.nesa.cap.gov> Look for the Air, Ground or Staff Curriculum. Second Find of FY14 – A ground team from Music City Squadron located the active ELT on the ramp at John Tune Airport. Coincidentally there was a nearby plane crash immediately after the ELT was disabled. A faint ELT signal was reported from the crash site. This highlights the importance of quickly finding every active ELT and insuring that they are properly disabled. The loud ELT from the ramp would have obscured the actual crash ELT and may have delayed the emergency response, if the crash had not been immediately reported.

New ESTO for Ground – We have recently appointed a new Emergency Services Training Officer, Capt Terry Logan. He will be focusing on improving the quality of our ground training. He is a long time CAP Ground Team Leader and Ranger. Professionally he has great experience with Emergency Services, Fire and Rescue, and the Military. He is based in Murfreesboro and active with the local squadron. Look for great things, coming soon.

ICUT required for renewal – ICUT becomes mandatory in September 2015. Anyone who has not completed ICUT before that time will have their ES Qualifications Suspended by WMIRS. Please ensure that you have properly recorded your ICUT completion before then.

Advanced Search Training – There will be 2 AFRCC courses held in Tennessee this year. Inland SAR Planning in Knoxville starting 7/21/2014 (5 days). Basic Inland SAR Course in Chattanooga starting 9/20/2014 (2 days).
